



Women's Steer Stopping Rules

- The year-end top 20 Steer Stoppers will rope two go-rounds on Thursday and Friday in the performance and the 3rd go-round on Saturday in the final rodeo performance.
- Contestants enter the event with the total points they've accumulated in the WSRRA for the 2023 rodeo season.
- Points will be awarded to the top six places per round and in the average:
 - 1st Place: 100
 - 2nd Place: 80
 - 3rd Place: 60
 - 4th Place: 40
 - 5th Place: 20
 - 6th Place: 10
- World Champion will be awarded to the highest total point earner of 2023 after the final round.
- Go-round champion award to winner of each of the 3 rounds and a award to the average winner.
- The barrier will be a barrel.
 - Broken barrier is a 10 second penalty.
- Roper calls for the animal from the header's box, chases steer down the arena, ropes around the neck, horns, or half head. Front leg is a no time.
- Contestant dallies and stops her horse.
- Time stops when the animal is under control and the horse and rope is stopped and dallies solid.
- 60 second time limit.
- Two loop limit.
- Slick horn only. No rubber, cotton rope, yarn.
- Tie downs will be allowed.
