- Entry Form
 - Return the entry form, with your fees, by **October 20th**; \$25 LATE FEE PER PERSON WILL APPLY
- Ranch Rodeo General Information & Rules

 - Code of Conduct will be enforced during the event. A copy is posted at <https://www.wsrro.org/>
 - The fastest time, including penalties, in the branding event will break any ties.
 - Western dress code will apply
 - Each contestant will receive one Contestant and one adult pass. Children under 12 are free admission. Additional passes are available for purchase at the event. Only one set of passes per contestant – not per event entered.
 - Participation in the Grand Entry for Thursday and Friday for all contestants is MANDATORY. Contestants returning to compete on Saturday in the finals are required to participate in the Grand Entry.
- Membership Support Programs
 - Cowboy Crisis Fund – a silent auction established to assist our injured or ill members and families
 - WSRRA Scholarship Fund – a raffle of custom items to support the next generation at school
- Schedule of Events
 - Team meeting will be held Thursday at 7:30 am.
 - Wednesday night are open jackpot ropings: Women's Steer Stopping, Fast Time Team Roping, Breakaway and Big Loop Team Roping. Enter onsite, cash only
 - Junior/Senior Ranch Rodeo Teams will be competing on Thursday and Friday
 - Boot Barn Kids Dummy Roping will follow Thursday-Slack Performance
 - Kids Boot Race during the performance on Thursday, Friday and Saturday
 - Jackpot Family Branding – sign up at the Rodeo Office, cash only – One WSRRA contestant, one youth under 16, one woman, and one "other" –Saturday, November 5th at 8:00 am

 - Stall and camping reservations shall be made in advance at www.bookwinnemuca.com Spaces may be limited or unavailable during large events.
 - All guests arriving during normal business hours – Monday thru Friday, 8 am to 5 pm (except holidays) – shall check-in at the FAIRGROUNDS OFFICE. Pre-registered guests must present a copy of their online receipt. All others shall pay at time of arrival.
 - All guests arriving after hours, holidays or weekends shall utilize the self-serve check-in system as follows:
 - If guest has a prepaid stall/camping reservation, please pick an unmarked stall and/or camping spot from the available stall/camping locations. A specific location is NOT being held in your name. Pick one that works best for you.
 - If guest does not have a prepaid reservation, please obtain a self-serve payment envelope located in front of the Fairgrounds or stall/camping offices. Pick a stall/camping spot from the available stall/camping locations. Complete the self-serve check-in envelope and include payment. Insert payment envelope in locked repository.
 - Shavings available onsite
 - RV hookups \$30/night; Stalls \$20/stall/night

Additional Contestant and General Information:

- This year's finals will include national T.V. coverage on The Cowboy Channel, Altitude Sports, RFD and possibly Ride TV. Professional team attire is encouraged for all competitors (i.e. team shirts etc.)
- All contestants are required to participate in Grand Entries.
- 9:00 pm Friday night Awards to be presented at Winners Inn & Casino and everyone is encouraged to attend. Children are welcome at the banquet room for awards.
- Jackpot events take place Wednesday at 6:00pm (CASH ONLY, enter at rodeo office). They include Open Team Roping, Breakaway, Women's Steer Stopping and Big Loop. Enter at event.
- Jackpot Family Branding is Saturday morning – Entries close at 8:00 PM Friday Night (CASH ONLY, enter at rodeo office)
- Only bronc riding contestants, stock contractors & their employees, and WSRRA staff will be allowed behind the bucking chutes or arena. No friends, family, or non-qualified bronc riders will be allowed in the arena or behind the bucking chutes.
